School Dinner Money / Airgead Dinneir: School lunches are available to all children in full time education and are FREE up until they reach P6 & 7 when the cost is £2.30 per day.

2 days - £4.60 3 days - £6.90 4 days - £9.20 5 days - £11.50 **Homework / Obair Dachaigh:** Reading/homework journals will be given to all learners again this year and daily reading remains a priority. We would be very grateful if you could regularly add your comments to these records too. Please can you listen to your children read as often as you can and discuss the stories / events etc. afterwards. Please also continue reading to your child, this is so important at all ages.

In addition to regular reading and book talk, class teachers will send home spelling and timetables/number practice along with additional games and website recommendations for you to use. Older children may bring home project work.

Meet & greet the teacher / Coinneachadh & fàilte: There will be the opportunity for parents to come and meet the new teachers next week, a time & date will go out on Seesaw.

Open Afternoon / Feasgar Fosgailte: There will be an open afternoon the week beginning 25th September. This is an opportunity for parents to get involved and engage with their child in their learning journey. More information will be sent out closer to the time.

Pupil assessment review / Lèirmheas measadh sgoilearan: Week beginning 4th September we will be sharing pupils baseline assessment results with parents. Week beginning 2nd October we will have an update on how pupils are progressing with their targets and setting their targets for the following term.

Visitors / Neach-tadhail: If you are visiting the school for any reason, please report to the office on arrival. If you need to contact the school during the school day, please note that the office is not always manned, and messages can be left on the answering machine. Thank you.

Absences / Neo-Lathaireachdean: If your child is going to be absent from nursery or school, please can you give this information to the school in advance. If your child is absent unexpectedly on any given day, please phone the school on 01470 521307 before 09.30am.

Forest School & Ocean school / Sgoil na Coille & Sgoil a'chuain: Please ensure that your child has wellies and waterproofs in school all the time as these sessions will be running at different times through the week.

Clothing / Aodach: Please can you write your child's name on their clothing, especially school jumpers. This helps us so much when we are trying to return 'lost items'. Please could we ask all children to bring in a pair of indoor crocs, trainers or shoes (NOT SLIPPERS) that will only be worn inside the school building. This will help to keep our carpets, cushions, rugs etc. clean and dry. If you prefer, wellies for outside play are a great alternative. It is also a good idea to make sure that ALL children have a spare change of clothes in school.

Snack / Biadh beag: Please can you send your child to school daily with a healthy morning snack. We do not operate a tuck bar at the moment.

Breakfast club / Club Bracaist: We successfully started running breakfast club last year, where pupils have access to breakfast before they start the school day. This is run by our wonderful helpers, who, without them, this would not happen. There is currently a gap on a Tuesday where there is no one to run breakfast club, and another few of the days could do with a second helper, so if you are free between 8.50 & 9.25am during term time and are able to help that would be wonderful. PE/ Sports: Please can you send in a PE kit with your child - including trainers, shorts, and a t-shirt. This can be left at school on their hanger or tray in class.

Music /Ceol: We continue to have music tuition for Pipe Band Drumming, Strings and Chanter, virtually and in school lessons.

Swimming / Snamh: We are delighted to finally be able to get back to our swimming lesson blocks with the school.

If we cannot get enough helpers to drive the minibus, we will need parents to help us with transport to and from Portree. More information will go out nearer the time.

- There will be no set 'Forest Schools' session for our nursery this term. The children will spend a lot of time exploring the outdoors during their sessions every day.

Message from teacher / Teachdaireachd bhon tidsear: Staff have asked if children can bring in an old shirt from home that can be used for art to protect the children's school uniform.


In-service Days / Latha Treanadh: Sgoil Araich & School will be closed on Monday 11th and Tuesday 12th September for staff training.
