The Children's Trophy / Cuach na Cloinne: Our GM4-7 pupils will take part in Cuach na Cloinne, a Gaelic run & led Football competition. This will take place at PHS on Tuesday 30th April. Pupils will travel to and from Portree on the Dunvegan Community Minibus, driven by a staff member. We will provide the children with a strip, but they need to have trainers / astro boots & shin guards.

Cross Country / Ruith: Cross country championships will take place this year on Wednesday 8th May at Portree High School.
